

SEMI EXPOSITIONS PRIORITY POINTS POLICY

We at SEMI value our members and their participation in our global SEMICON, SOLARCON and FPD Expositions. One of the many benefits of Membership is the opportunity to accumulate priority points for Expositions. For Expositions, booth space is assigned according to the SEMI Priority Points Policy. Priority points are accumulated per Member Company based on the expositions where the member participates and, in most cases, based on the amount of booth space the exhibitor is assigned.

Member companies that exhibit in four (4) or more expositions in one (1) calendar year or exceed 200 paid square meters of exhibit space per year will receive a 40% discount on their SEMI membership for the following renewal year.

Below is an explanation of how priority points are accumulated, retained or forfeited.

Exposition:	Member Participation Points	Booth Points
Korea, China, Singapore, Russia, Taiwan, Europa, West	One (1) point per year, per tradeshow at which it exhibits	0.25 per each 9 sq mt or 100 sq ft space contracted
Japan	Same as above.	No Booth Points

1. **Member Participation Points:** Member Participation Points are awarded to active SEMI member companies or companies with a member parent, and are accumulated annually for the exposition(s) where the company exhibited.
2. **Booth Points:** Booth Points are derived from the total paid exhibit space by SEMI members or their subsidiary or sales office (per table above). Only Subsidiary and sales offices recognized by SEMI may use their parent company membership to accumulate Booth Points.
3. **Membership Cancellation:** If SEMI cancels a membership due to non payment of membership dues, or if a company cancels their own membership, all priority points are forfeited. If the same company brings their membership up-to-date and provides payment for 'back dues', the company can keep all previous points earned. If the same company renews their membership, but prefers not to provide payment for 'back dues', the priority points begin accumulating from zero.
4. **Company Mergers:** If two member companies merge, the higher of the two priority point totals follow the new membership. Priority points are not merged.
5. **Company Splits:** If a member company splits or spins off, the parent company will keep all priority points. If the new company obtains a SEMI membership, it will keep only the Booth Points it accumulated previously. This also applies when a Subsidiary Office chooses to separate from the parent company and creates their own membership.
6. **Co-exhibitor Participation:** Member **Paid** Co-exhibitors receive one (1) Membership Point per exposition per year in which it participates and will not accumulate any Booth Points.
7. **Change to SEMICON West and SEMICON Russia Point Calculation:** Effective July 2008, calculation of points for SEMICON West changed from 1 Participation Point only to include Booth Points plus participation point. SEMICON Russia exhibitors, beginning in 2008, receive 1 Participation Point and also Booth Points.
